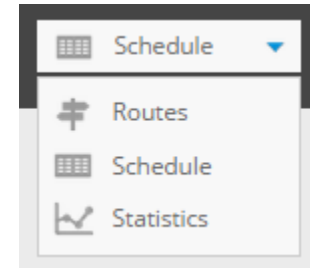

## View and save results

# 1.- Viewing results

You can view the results as a grid, report, statistics, map and routes. We recommend you to use the following three:



## A) Route:

This option allows you to geographically locate the itineraries to perform directly on the map. Straight lines are the outline of the route; when you check the path to the GPS or mobile app the route might also be displayed street by street.

This option provides an overview of the planning of all daily routes organized by vehicle



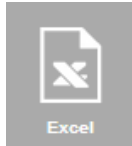
**C) Statistics:**

### B) GPS

Download the proper file for your GPS.  
Click on the file type according to the model of your GPS:

For a Garmin GPS: click ".gpx"  
For a Tom Tom GPS: click ".itn"  
From your PC, you must copy the file to your GPS.
